Cart Fees and Plans

Cart Lease Club and Trail Fee [use of a Privately-Owned Cart] is available to Full Members only**

Unlimited Trail Fee Family...billed semi-annually at \$ 875 for an annual fee of \$ 1,750.00

Unlimited Trail Fee Single...billed semi-annually at \$ 625 for an annual fee of \$ 1,250.00

Per Round Trail Fee usage at \$ 12.75 per 18-hole round

Club Cart Rental at \$19.00 per 18-hole round

Club Cart Lease Plan...billed quarterly at \$ 312.50 for an annual fee of \$ 1,250.00 [plus tax]

***Club Members may use a privately-owned cart on the Azalea/Challenge courses as a courtesy [cart fees need to be paid] ...all privately-owned carts to be used must be registered with the Club.*

Full Privilege Membership...

This membership entitles a Member and Family to use of all the Club facilities, including golf (the Magnolia, the Holly, the Azalea and the 3-hole Challenge golf courses), tennis, swimming, and clubhouse without payment of court, pool or green fees.

Club Membership [formally Social/Tennis]...

This membership entitles a Member and eligible family members to use the Club facilities, including the 3-hole Challenge golf course, tennis, swimming and clubhouse without payment of usage fees.

The Club Membership includes a limited number of rounds on the Holly and Magnolia golf courses with the payment of a reduced green fee. The Azalea golf course can be enjoyed on an unlimited basis with the payment of a reduced green fee.

Club Memberships may be upgraded to a "higher" category of membership, provided that the applicable Transfer Fee paid is commensurate to the category of membership to which the "upgrade" is applied.

Leisure Membership...

This membership entitles a Member and eligible family members to use the Club facilities, including the 3-hole Challenge golf course, tennis, swimming and clubhouse without payment of usage fees.

Leisure Members are entitled to discounted rounds [based on the applicable unaccompanied rates being charged] on the Magnolia, Holly and Azalea golf courses.

Leisure Memberships may be upgraded to a "higher" category of membership, provided that the applicable Transfer Fee paid is commensurate to the category of membership to which the "upgrade" is applied.

The newly renovated Swimming Pool...

The newly renovated “saltwater” Pool is available to ALL members of Pinewild, and their accompanied guests, at NO cost.

The Challenge Golf Course...

The recently renovated [3-hole] Challenge Course is available to ALL members of Pinewild, and their accompanied guests, at NO cost...including complimentary Cart usage when available.

Free Range Ball program for Full Members [new in 2018]...

Each Full Membership will receive a Range Key, loaded with \$150 worth of “range usage” for 2018.

Options for Members to use their Privately-Owned Cart...

Full Members of the Club may participate in several different options, whereby a Member can utilize a privately-owned cart on the golf courses. These options for Full Members include per round usage or an annual fee for unlimited usage. Additionally, Club [or Social/Tennis Members] may also utilize their privately-owned cart [new in 2018], but ONLY on the Azalea and Challenge courses, and only as a convenience, with the applicable cart fee still needing to be paid. ALL privately-owned carts to be used on the golf facilities MUST be registered with the Club.

Reciprocal Play at Ten other regional courses...

Over the past several years, Pinewild has nurtured great relationships with numerous Clubs in the region. Several of these Clubs are private, and all present a great opportunity for all of our Members to travel and play a course in Cary, Lexington, Greensboro, and several other locations.

Play Day with the Professional Staff...

All members have numerous opportunities throughout the season to play with a member of our talented professional staff...this in a fun and relaxing environment.

Discounts on Golf Shop Merchandise and Dining...

All members will receive a member’s discount of 20% on all items in the golf shop. Items include apparel, shoes, hats, bags, clubs, etc. If members wish to special order an item, they will still receive their member’s discount, but are responsible for paying the Shipping/ Handling charges. The member discount may not be used in addition to sales and promotions offered in the golf shop. Additionally, Members receive a dining discount of 15% off Lunch menu items in our restaurant.

Quarterly guest day competitions for Full Members and their non-member guests...

Management wants your guests to experience the fantastic Pinewild environment. Full Members will have the opportunity to bring non-member guests to Pinewild to participate in a “fun” day of

competition. These discounted “guest days” will be held every quarter and will accommodate men, women and mixed teams, with food and prizes included.

The KidzWild program...

Now in its third year, this program has started to gain traction with some good participation. The program allows all Members’ children and their accompanied guests to enjoy events held on selected days ...activities include Lunch with Santa, the Easter Egg Hunt, Cooking Class with Chef, Movie Nights, amongst others, as well as Dive-in Movie Nights at the pool.

Grandchildren can play for just a Cart Fee...

Accompanied Grandchildren of all Members who are under the age of twenty-one will receive a free green fee, and may play for just a cart fee.

Free Golf to all Member “juniors” under the age of 18 years old...

Pinewild is a leader in the region as it relates to junior golf. This includes the option for all Members under the age of 18 to walk the courses [after 2pm] at no charge.

Free Mini-lessons and Demo Days...

The Pinewild Academy continues to host numerous game-improvement activities to help the Membership improve their golf skills. These includes Gus Ulrich, PGA [2016 and 2017 Carolinas PGA Senior Player of the Year] holding free mini-lessons on the range on selected days, as well as numerous “equipment demo days” during the golfing season where Members can test the latest golf equipment.

The four **Har-Tru tennis courts**, which are available to all Members at no charge, consistently remain among some of the best-conditioned in the area, with lighting options available for evening play.

Boasting the **Holly, Magnolia and Azalea** [9-hole] courses, Pinewild continues to play host to many prestigious USGA, CGA and PGA qualifiers and championships, which are open to Members as volunteers or spectators.

Lake Pinewild, a 25 acre lake, is owned and managed by the Club. This amenity provides great opportunities for fishing, non-motorized boating, or simply just viewing, and lies adjacent to the beach, boat ramp and picnic area which is under the purview of the Property Owners Association.

The Pinewild **Clubhouse** plays host to a variety of Social opportunities for Members ...including wide-ranging Food and Beverage service, Trivia Nights, Card Nights, special Themed Socials and Dinners, and a wide variety of specialized Member clubs which focus on activities and hobbies other than just golf.
