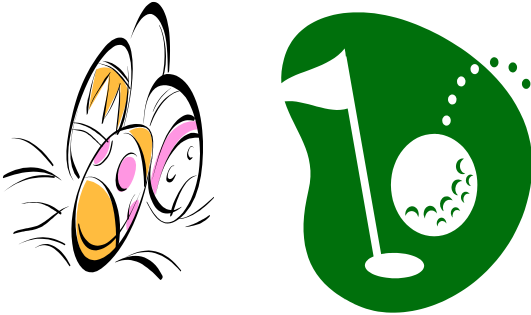

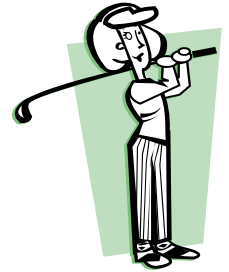

On Tuesday, March 7th, 92 members of the PWGA opened the 2017 season with delicious food, good fun and laughter. The weatherman cooperated with wonderful weather as we headed out to the Holly course with string in hand. Our 'extra' ten feet of string, per foursome, allowed us to one putt from anywhere on the green, keeping those gross scores well under par. Special thanks to our Social Chair, Joan Power, and her committee members Kay Cormier and Sue Wilson, who helped organize and decorate for the day's festivities.

More than thirty women were acknowledged at the opening meeting, as they are the bones of our organization. Our league does not work without their efforts. Elected officers, committee chairs and event coordinators spend many hours working for the benefit of all. Our new head-pro, Kyle Kirk, was introduced to the members along with our three newest members: Ann Blayney, Tami Ostroski and Joyce Reynolds. As of this printing we wish to welcome Wendy Schreiber, who joined the PWGA just after the opener. With the addition of Wendy, there are currently 130 members in the league.



Two new concepts were introduced at the meeting: First, the new, and hopefully improved, CIC (Chip in Club) and secondly, PWGA LITE. In the past, those players wishing to participate in chip-ins deposited a quarter in a box, wrote their name on a sheet and hoped to collect much of the pot later that day. This year, the Board was given the nod by the members to pre-pay \$5 for the entire year, thus eliminating the need to remember the quarter each time you played. Seventy-two of our members decided to participate in this year's CIC. PWGA LITE allows PWGA members to play only nine holes on many Tuesday play days. We are all anticipating our one-day Member/Guest tournament to be played on Tuesday, April 25th. Carol Angus and her committee have been diligently working on our annual event. This year's theme is 'Friendships Links us Together'. The sign-up sheet is posted in the locker room; cost for the event is \$150 per twosome. A light breakfast will be provided, box lunch on the course along with the 'booze buggy', with dinner scheduled at 6 p.m. that evening.
