As we wrap-up a very busy 2016, most of the planning is complete for another busy year in 2017. This includes numerous Club Golf, Social and other events. Please ensure you stop by the Golf Shop to get 2017 Events Calendar. A reminder...entry information will soon be available for the very popular spring Charity Event on April 19th...the worthy charity selected for 2017 will be the Linden Lodge.

As has been the case in the past, we will once again be completing some general maintenance and cleaning of the Clubhouse in late January. With this in mind, the restaurant and ALL dining & bar service will be unavailable from Monday the 23rd through Thursday the 26th. Lunch and regular food and beverage service will then start back on Friday the 27th. The Snack Bar will be available during this time, with "normal" hours and menu items available.

As we move into February, work will soon begin on the Pool Facility renovations. This will include a comprehensive resurfacing of the pools and surrounding concrete, as well as a new pump and filtration system. The system will be salt based, as opposed to the current chemical system. The renovations will take about six weeks, and the pool is scheduled to open on time in late May.

The courses remain in good condition, and the staff remains busy this winter...projects include additional irrigation, drainage on Magnolia 14 and Holly 16, as well as additional tree removal and continued bunker renovation on the Holly.
