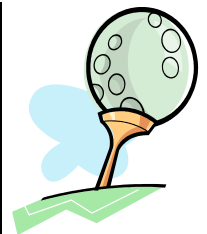

PINWILD WOMEN'S GOLF ASSOCIATION

At our Board meeting on August 3rd, we discussed the request from 2019 Member-Guest Chairperson Judith Kelly to have a two-day tournament in 2019. We also realized that there is not a procedure in place for the Tar-heel competitions when the event is oversubscribed. Chairperson Diane Vosilus will develop a procedure to be discussed at the October 3rd meeting and thereafter to be included in the Standing Rules. Both Judith and Diane will be guests at the October 3rd meeting to discuss these two issues with the Board members.

Chairperson Lydia Healy of the Nominating Committee for 2019 reported that all the executive positions have been filled, to be announced in November to the membership for voting at the closing luncheon in December.

Interclub Team I is now in second place with 151 points behind Country Club of Whispering Pines. The final match will be held on September 17th at Foxfire. Pinewild needs to win over CCWP by 5 points in order to retain the Trophy. Interclub Team II standings as of August 14th are Pinehurst #9 157 points, Pinehurst Resort and CC 149.5 and Pinewild in third place with 145.5 points. The final match will be held September 18th at Pinehurst #7.

Pinetop finished its fifth match of the season placing in first position with 62 points, only 1 point ahead of CCWP (61). Finals will be held September 19th at Southern Pines Country Club.

In 2017 both Pinetop and Interclub I won first place recognitions.

Upcoming events in September include the Sadie Hawkins one day event with golf (Pinehurst Modified Alternate Shot) and luncheon in which PWGA members invite PMGA members to be part of two person team. Sign-up is ongoing now with at least 59 of the 64 teams already enrolled.

The ever popular Solheim Cup will take place September 24, 25, and 27th. Sign-up is in the Ladies Locker Room. In preparation for the Solheim Cup, Tuesday Play Day on September 4th is scheduled as a practice format with BB, alternate-shot and scramble formats. Ladies not playing in the Solheim may also play in this event with a partner.

To help the PWGA players "BEAT THE HEAT" and deal with the aerated greens...Tournament Directors Paula Montgomery and Chris Johnson sponsored a Fun-Fun Format for the August 21st Play Day. 3-3-3 meant that every 3 holes had a different theme for the teams of ABCD players. Holes 1-3 was 1 net Best Ball, 4-6 was a scramble, 7-9 was alternate shot as a team, with Player A hitting each drive. This order was repeated for the second 9 holes. The rounds went quickly and were received with much enjoyment and team spirit. Our thanks to Paula and Chris for such a clever plan! Winning team was Paula Montgomery, Talie Tuffnell, Jean Weiler and Kathy Samchalk with 65.
