Please verify all scores before turning in the signed card. Scores should be posted as soon as possible, but must be posted before the scorecards are turned over to the handicap chair on Saturday.

The PWGA will follow Pinewild Club rules on playing conditions. The club has determined that winter rules are in effect through April 1. On those days where the club has designated Cart Path Only, the PWGA will automatically invoke the “lift, clean and place” rule in closely mown areas.

- **The PWGA Shoot Out:**

The Shoot Out will be held on November 6, 2018.

To qualify: Play in PWGA play days and major events. The more you play, the more points you earn towards being one of 8 players with the most accumulated points for entrance into the Shoot Out.

Receive 1 point for playing in regular play day; 3 points for playing in a low gross/low net peer play day; and 6 points for playing in any of these major events:

 Holly Challenge Tournament
 Think Pink Tournament
 Solheim Cup

October 23rd is the last play day to accumulate points.

Play Off Format: Field of 8 players. Starting on Hole 15 of the Mag, 2 players with the highest net score will be eliminated on each hole until the Shoot Out champion is decided on Hole 18. Ties on all holes will be decided by a chip or putt off.

Prize: Free PWGA dues (a \$50 value) for 2019.
